The Stock Market Game™ is a national program of the Foundation for Investor Education and is offered in Kentucky by the Kentucky Council on Economic Education (KCEE). It is an interactive, interdisciplinary program for students in grades 4-12 (and college) to learn about economics, finance, and our American economic system. The program is offered each Fall and Spring. Over a period of 15 weeks, teams of students research companies, make investment decisions, and create their portfolios, investing \$100,000 in imaginary money in stocks and mutual funds. Teams are ranked on equity in portfolio. Teachers are provided with educational resources to teach students about investing, the stock market, and the economy. Students use practical applications in math, reading, research, technology and team decision-making.

Student teams compete against other Kentucky teams statewide and across local regions for prizes. For Fall 2007, 578 teams of 2,145 students and 67 teachers participated in our Stock market Game competition. Another 74 teachers and 426 teams of 1,788 students

took part in the Take Stock in Kentucky competition this Fall, with Woodford County Middle School taking first place in the state.

For this fall and last Spring, AAPL (Apple) and GOOG (Google) stock were the big winners in top portfolios. But, BIDU (BAIDU.com) caught the eye of the top winners, as it increased in value nearly 75% over the past 3 months. Baidu.com is a Chinese company, based in Beijing, China that provides Chinese language Internet search services. It is traded on the NASDAQ and was just recently added to the NASDAQ 100 index.

KCEE congratulates the winners and all students who took part in the Stock Market Game program. The experience gives students a real-life experience and knowledge that they will take to adulthood.

Stock Market Game awards include: 1st place prize of \$300, 2nd place of \$200, and 3rd place of \$100 to be used by the school, class, or team, plus \$50 for a class pizza party. The first place state awards team will receive class trophies and medals at the Kentucky Council on Economic Education Annual Awards program in May, 2008. The top 10 teams in the state will all receive Stock Market Game Winners Tshirts. The top team in each region will also receive a check for \$50 for the team or class.

What students gain from The Stock Market GameTM program is a remarkable experience — and even more important, an education for life.
