Take Stock in Kentucky is our own "Kentucky version" of The Stock Market Game™ which gives students the opportunity to learn about and invest in Kentucky businesses and companies important to the local economy. Using the Stock Market Game program, a national program of the Foundation for Investor Education with an investment simulation, students also learn about economics, finance, and our American economic system. Teachers are provided with educational resources to teach students about investing, capital formation, the stock market, and the economy. The program is offered each Fall and Spring.

In Take Stock in Kentucky, teams of students research Kentucky companies, make investment decisions, and create their portfolios, investing \$100,000 in imaginary money in stocks over a 10

week period. Teams are ranked on equity in portfolio. Student teams compete against other Kentucky teams statewide and across local regions for prizes. For Spring 2008, 60 teachers and 384 teams of 1,628 students took part in the Take Stock in Kentucky competition. For the Stock Market Game also offered this spring, 779 teams of 2,751 students and 88 teachers participated with Tates Creek High School in Lexington taking first place.

Most of the winning portfolios held United States Steel (X) stock which increased in value from \$100.27/share to \$154.55/share over the 10 weeks of the competition. Additionally, Industrial Services of America (IDSA) was the winning stock for the first place team from Indian Hills Elementary in Christian County.

Take Stock in Kentucky awards include: 1st place prize of \$300, 2nd place of \$200, and 3rd place of \$100 to be used by the school, class, or team, plus \$50 for a class pizza party. The first place state awards team from Indiana Hills Elementary will receive class trophies and medals at the KCEE Luncheon to be held on June 26 at the *Life Fundamental\$* Financial Literacy Summit in Louisville. The top 10 teams in the state will all receive "I Took Stock in Kentucky...and Won! Tshirts. The top team in each region will also receive a check for \$50 for the team or class.
